- Due to the number of ladies we are expecting, please do not bring your own glasses or coffee cups.
 Drinks will be served in clear plastic cups from the kitchen. Service goes faster if the clear plastic cups are used.
- Multiple coffee stations will be available for self-service. Cups and creamers will be there as well.
- The Women's Ministry has white, cream, brown, and black round tablecloths available or you may provide your own. Please wash before you return a borrowed tablecloth.
- As the hostess for your table, please arrive by 5:30 so that you can greet your guests as they arrive.
