

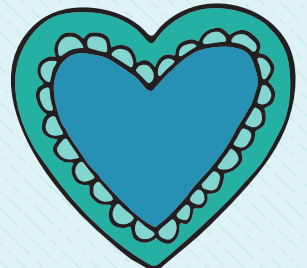
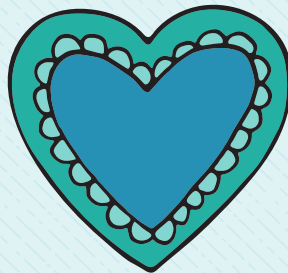

Jesus Taught to Love One Another

—Based on Matthew 5:1-2,43-48;
 Mark 12:28-31

One day Jesus saw crowds, and He went up on a mountain. He sat down with His disciples (helpers) and began to teach the people. Jesus taught that they should love other people, even when they act mean or unkind.

Another time, Jesus and some of the temple (church) leaders were talking. A man heard them, and he wanted to ask Jesus a question.

He asked, "What is the most important commandment (law)?"

Jesus said, "There is one God. The most important commandment is to love God very much—with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength."

"The second most important commandment," Jesus said, "is to love other people as much as you love yourself. These are the greatest commands."
