The church in Antioch gave money and food to help the people in Judea. Count the coins in the boxes below. Place an X on the box that has the most coins.

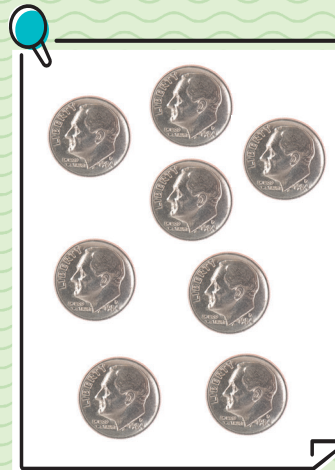
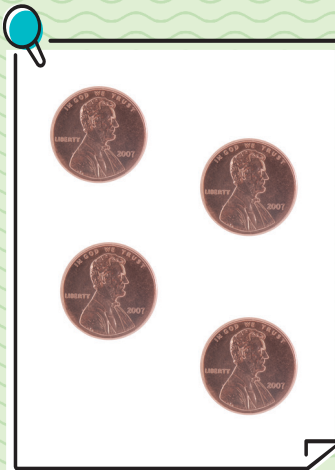
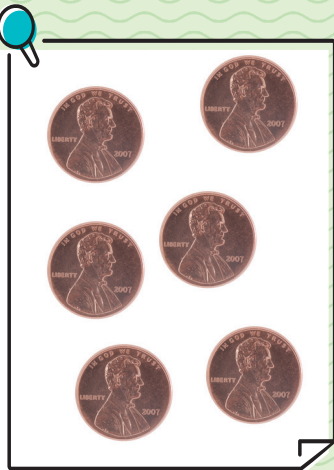

—Based on Acts 11:19-30

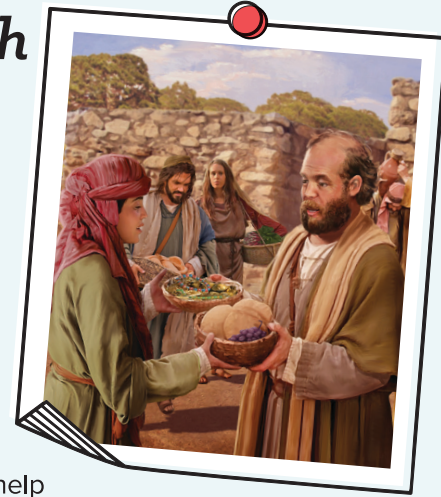
The people in the Jerusalem church heard about a new church in Antioch. They sent Barnabas to visit the Antioch church. Barnabas encouraged the people in the new church. Many people in Antioch began to believe that Jesus was God's Son.

Barnabas brought Saul to Antioch to help teach the people. They stayed in Antioch for a year. They taught many people about Jesus. The people who believed in Jesus were called Christians.

One day some men from Jerusalem came to the Antioch church. One of the men, a prophet named Agabus (AG uh buhs), told the church that soon the people in Judea would not have enough food to eat. Many people would be hungry.

The people in the Antioch church decided to help. Everyone in the Antioch church gave as much food and money as they could. Barnabas and Saul took their gifts to the people in the church in Judea.
