LIFE POINT

People can choose to do what is good.

THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE

Rahab chose to obey God and do what is good when she hid the Israelite spies. Like Rahab, we can choose to obey God and do what is good, too.

Joshua sent two spies to Jericho. A woman named Rahab hid the spies so they could not be found. The men promised Rahab that she and everyone in her house would be saved if she tied a red rope to her window.

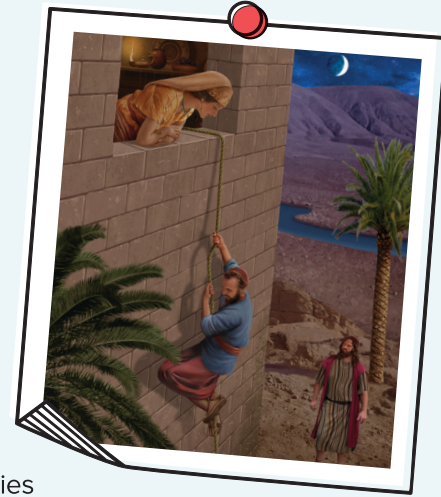
Rahab helped the men leave the city and tied the rope to her window. The spies hurried back to Joshua and told him that God would give the city to them.

God told Joshua, "March around Jericho once each day for six days. On the seventh day, march around the city seven times. Tell the priests to blow their trumpets and the people to shout. Then the wall will fall."

Joshua obeyed God. For six days, the Israelites marched around Jericho. Then on the seventh day, they marched around the city seven times. After the seventh time, the priests blew the trumpets. Joshua told the people to shout. They shouted, and the wall of Jericho fell.

Joshua sent the two spies to rescue Rahab and all the people in her home. From then on, Rahab lived with the Israelites.
